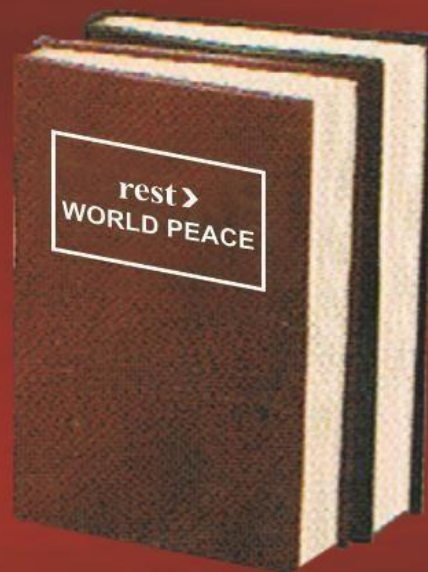

'FREE AT LAST': REAL HISTORICAL FACTS

I am talking of those times The Rule of 'King Babar' started in the year 1582. But prior to this, about 350 years earlier 'Mughal Empire' had already been established in India. In the period of 'Babar', such a great messenger of God was born, who gave further lift to the philosophy of 'Vedas' and also united Hinduism in a compact manner. Who was this religious Guide! **He was Holy Guru, Guru Nanak Dev Ji**; whatever seed was shown by him, started bearing fruit, that was a natural spirit, and brotherhood. This was basically message of Almighty, which was spread.

India's struggle for freedom-National Spirit: Gandhi Ji lived in South Africa for 20 years. During this period, he developed a strong system of non-violence. Gandhi Ji returns to India in January 1915 and peoples awakening fight for their rights and use methods of non-violence that is 'Satyagraha'. The people lovingly addressed him as Mahatma (Great Soul) and Bapu (Father of the Nation). 'Bharat Ratna' Dr. Sh. B.R Ambedkar Ji (Father of the Indian Constitution and Messiah of Down trodden) raised his voice for the people of low castes or 'Dalits' with the support of Mahatma Gandhi Ji in 1932, and addressed the Dalits with a new name, 'Harigans', which means the 'children of God'.

Gandhi Ji launched the Quit India Movement or the Bharat Chhodo Andolan in August 1942. He issued a call for the 'British' to "Quit India" immediately. The British Government was against this Movement and reached brutally by arresting all congress leaders, and thousands of Indians. Gandhi Ji was held for two years. Everyone contributed what they could in freedom struggled. **Mahatma Gandhi Ji, Sardar Bhagat Singh**, and his colleagues brought the story of influential and revolutionary aspect of the freedom movement. Other 'Heroes' also struggled. Lala Lajpat Rai Ji, 'A Freedom Fighter' who likes a true soldier fought to the last breath and died in the battlefield of freedom. He was truly called "Lion of Punjab". Sh. Chander Shakhazad, Sh. Jawaharlal Nehru, Shri Jaiprakash Narayan - (The People's Hero, he was awarded the Bharat Ratna, India's Highest Civilian Award, in Recognition of his social work) and my **father** Late Shri. Bharat Lal Behl, and also including so many other freedom fighters took pledge - and sees a new vision for India. After many sacrifices and tireless efforts, India finally became independent on August 1947.

Gandhi Ji says: Walk with love together and peaceful protest and non - violent movements - and care towards children, orphans and poor than overflow will come. '**Mother Teresa**' dedicated her entire life to the service of the poorest of the poor. As a foreigner she settled in Kolkata's (India) and nursed those, who suffered from 'Leprosy and Cancer'. 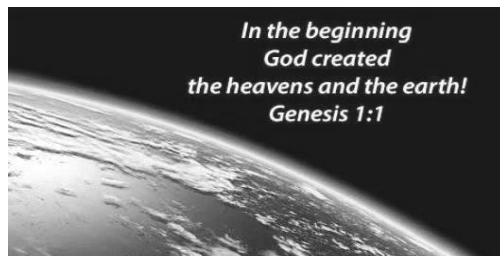

GOD'S PLAN: His Greatest Gift!

ADAM AND EVE WAS NOW PASSED ON INTO THEIR TWO SONS. Families grew, and men began to populate the earth. But as men spread out, the evil of sin grew, and the evil with them also grew so because bringing misery and death to God's beautiful creation. God, who is holy, painfully decides to destroy mankind because of their great wickedness. However, God has made a promise that he would send a Savior. He must keep his promise. He finds one good, righteous man, whose name is 'Noah'. God decided to save him and his family from the flood and preserve a family for which he can bring a savior.

GOD CALLS ABRAHAM (GENESIS CHAPTER 12). It is now several thousand years after creation, and hundreds of years after the flood. Men have once again populated the earth. Most of the men were very sinful. But there is small number who still worship the one true God and who do not worship idols. Beginning of chapter 12, Book Genesis tells a different kind of story - that of a single family. The story slows to develop the personalities of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Joseph - Gods plan were for them, as individuals. Abraham loved and trusted God. When God was ready to build a nation for Himself, he came to Abraham. God promised a mighty nation would come from Abraham; it was then that God gave to him a son Isaac. Isaac was born miraculously from parents who were much too old to have children. God continued to develop the new nation of Israel by giving two sons to Isaac, (Jacob and Esau).

JACOB WAS TO BE PART OF GOD'S PLAN. (GENESIS 32:25-28) God chose Jacob to extent his blessings to all. Something very unusual happened to this girl. An angel appeared to her one day and told her that she was going to have a baby. This would be a very special baby because he would become the Savior of the world. Mary was excited and thrilled that the baby she was going to have was to be the Son of God, the Savior of the world! 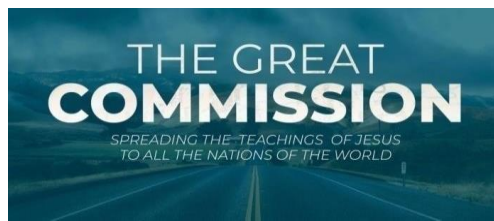

In the name of justice, people laughed at him, and among two dacoits he was hanged on the cross. One of the criminals hanging on the cross. And he said to Jesus, 'Remember me, when you come as king!' Jesus said to him, *"I promise you that today you will be in paradise with me."* (Luke 23: 39-43).

Jesus said to His disciples: "The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations. You are witness of these things." In the book of Acts Chapter one verse 3 Jesus also presented himself alive- for forty days after his death that he was alive, and commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Holy Spirit and you shall be witnesses to me, in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. (Acts 1:8).

As Commanded by Jesus... SURELY I AM WITH YOU ALWAYS, TO THE VERY END OF THE AGE. Please see the book Act Chapter 4. History records His faithful believers at all times have suffered and sacrificed much for the cause of Christ: St. Stephen proved the discipleship in Christ when he forgives his killers. He cried out, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them" (Acts 7:60). The weapons Jesus left us Are prayer, forgiveness, love, compassion and tolerance. God is love, actively demonstrated his love through Jesus Christ, through him, offered salvation to all mankind. "GO" The great commission (Matthew 28:19-20).

Through the scriptures, I came to know the beginning of the universe, and the Beginning of sin and perhaps most important the beginning of God's work to restore in sinful humanity.

History records they were severely beaten with many stripes and were cast into prison and their feet put in stock we read in Book Acts. The apostles peter and John, were arrested for preaching through the resurrection of the dead. We read in Acts 4:1-2. The real power at work in the book ACTS.

“Saul” was till threats against the Lord’s disciples. He believed that salvation could be obtained by obedience to all of the laws of ‘Moses’ that God had given to his people... but a view religious movement was a group of people who claimed to be followers of ‘Jesus’, a man who had been crucified, but they now believed had ‘risen’ from the dead, ascended to heaven, and would return in power and great glory. He (Paul) hunted down the members of this group, had them committed to prison, and threatened them with death. He went to the high priest and asked him for letters to the Synagogues in Damascus, so that if found any there who belonged to the way, whether men or women, he might take them as prisoners to Jerusalem. As he was near ‘Damascus’ on the journey, suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him. He felt on the ground and heard a voice, “Saul, why do you persecute me?” verse 5 Chapter 9 “who are you, Lord?” Saul asked, “I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting...” He never saw Jesus before His death and resurrection.

When Jesus appeared on the road to Damascus, he was getting a persecutor and a violent man; God turned many a ‘Saul’ into a ‘Paul’ Jesus himself call Paul “... a chosen vessel of mine” **God said to Ananias, “Go” !** This man is chosen instrument to proclaim my name Pl. see (Book Acts 9:1-9; 22:6-16; 26:12-23). Acts 22- Paul’s Jerusalem Sermon: He begins his message to the mob. 1 to 3 verses “Brethren and fathers, hear my defense before you now.” He tells of his Jewish upbringing and background. “I am indeed a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, taught according to the strictness of our father’s law, and was zealous toward God as you all are today.” In the verse 4-5 he tells how he persecuted Christians. “I presented this way to the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women, as also the high priest hears me witness, and all the council of the elders, from whom I also received letters to thebreathern, and went to Damascus to bring in chains even those who were there to Jerusalem to be punished.” In the verse 6 to 16 he describes his supernatural experience on the way to Damascus...”

Jesus Christ show his long - suffering (Patience) with other people, by showing Paul as an example a murder of Christians, now chosen by Jesus, to carry the Gospel of salvation in many parts of the world. St. Paul wrote half of the New Testament and show Christ is the "One Mediator God and Men". (2 Timothy 2:5). The book 'Acts' and the letters from 'Roman to Revelation' discuss the deep significance of the resurrected Christ. The Revelation to John was written at a time when all believers were being persecuted because of theirfaith in Jesus Christ. And give the hope and encouragement during times of suffering and persecution – and visions presented in (symbolic language) that would have been understood by all believers of that day. The Book of Revelation tells: **“your concern should not be when the world will end,** instead, your main focus should be seek God to be spiritually prepared for the time that are coming, and also encourage us to live pure and holy lives (2 Peter 3:15-18). God islove, actively demonstrated his love through Jesus Christ, through him, offered salvation to all mankind.

God Himself becoming a curse for all mankind;

His love is “without limits”. And His Name shall be called prince of peace Isaiah 9:6

Message of Salvation

The Lamb's Salvation story, St. John insists, stands.

The book of revelation provides a closing summary of the Bible's salvation story in the form of an extended vision that interprets Jesus message of salvation.

The first words of the book of revelation tells us this is a "revelation of Jesus Christ". This book is a revelation a vision of how his salvation transforms the world. The book challenges us to accept Jesus Lamb-power as the fundamental power of history. Evil is defeated not by overwhelming force or violence but by the Lamb's of God – suffering love on the cross. This is how St. John describes Jesus: "the faithful witness, the first born of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth" (1:5). In revelation, the visions John sees reveal Lamb-power as the true power of the universe-exalted Lamb-as Lamb, not as warrior, because of his faithful witness to preserving compassion and love-that in his death and resurrection Christ has already won his decisive victory over evil. "This Jesus love us and has freed us from our sins by his blood". The work of 'love' that Jesus has as its goal the setting free of enslaved creation, especially enslaved humanity. The fundamental sin in the Bible is idolatry, trusting in things rather than – God.

John has in mind the overall life, death, resurrection of Jesus. Jesus provides a "freedom from": freedom from the powers and from idolatry and from sin, all the aspects of life that lead to enslavement. However, Jesus also provides "freedom for." The 'gospel' tells us that the way of victory for the 'messiah' came through the Jesus self-sacrifice. The symbol of the 'lamb' is no less a divine symbol that the symbol of the one who sits on the throne. "worthy is the lamb that was slaughtered to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!" revelation, teaches that the lamb of God has defeated the powers of evil. This act leads to eventual healing of creation, healing that includes the transformation of the nations and their kings. The lamb who defeated evil through the way of love reveals the path of salvation, of hope and empowerment in the midst of tribulations and persecutions and evil. " a great multitude that no one could count" (7:9). The Lamb's Salvation story, St. John insists, stands. After the celebration in 19:1-10, "heaven is opened" for a new vision. Jesus returns to the scene – for a new vision. It appears he will act as judge. "All the rest". The white horse that Jesus rides symbolize victory. He has conquered through his death and resurrection. The armies of heaven-like the "saints" carry no weapons. They too are already victorious. The only weapon is the sword that comes out of Jesus mouth-his word, the 'Gospel' t hat brings the enemies of God to their knees.

The bible's vision wholeness is presented most clearly at the very end, the last two chapters of revelation. The angel tells John that God "will wipe every tear from our eyes. Death will no more" (21:4). Then John sees a vision of the city of healing and wholeness, the New Jerusalem. The angel showed me (John) the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the 'throne of God' and the 'Lamb' through the middle of the street of the city. On either side of the river is the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, producing its fruit each month; and the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations. Nothing assured will be found there. But the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and his servants will worship him; they will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads. And there will be on more night; they need no light of lamp or sun, for the lord God will be their light (22:1-5). God had promised to Abraham and Sarah that their descendents would be a light to the nations, and bring healing and salvation. This promise finds fulfillment in the New Jerusalem. The nations are healed. Jesus has conquered death. Revelation's hope is based on what Jesus already did. Look!

The Lamb is worthy to take the scroll, the Lamb
has true power, because it was willing to be slain for the sake of God's truth.

THE GIFTS OF GOD ARE GIVEN FREELY TO US...

We believe that His power and wisdom are great and his love for us is so strong that He has in fact done the 'impossible' and has come to us in Jesus and spoken to us in the Bible.

God's greatest revelation of himself to us is in the life and ministry and teaching of Jesus Christ. He comes directly to us through the Holy Spirit. Down through the ages he has met with men and women personally: with Moses at the burning bush, or with others in different ways. He has revealed himself and his truth to us in the Bible. For example, the four gospels give us accounts of Jesus being crucified. In Romans, we find a closely argued explanation of what the cross really means, and of how an event on a Friday can transform our relationship with the living God. In His wisdom and love God has chosen to give us the rich and complex collection of history and theology, of poetry and prophecy, of stories of Jesus and personal letters, as a message from him to all who read or hear it. As St. Paul put it when he was writing all scripture in God- breathed or inspired by God in a Unique way (2 Timothy 3:16). His statement that all the Old Testament, scriptures were God – breathed, he taught that they were in fact 'the very words of God' (Romans 3:2). In the way the believers of the early were able to say that the words of one of the Psalms were actually God speaking by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of King David (Act 4:25).

Besides teaching that Old Testament Scriptures were inspired by God, Jesus claimed God's authority for his own words (John 14:24). Throughout the New Testament the apostles were aware that the message they proclaimed and the teaching they gave was not theirs but God's. They could not be silent, because they had to 'Obey God' (Acts 5:29). **St. Paul received his message not from any man**, but by revelation from Jesus Christ. The book of Revelation is also called God given (Revelation 1:1). We find it hard to understand how the infinite God came to this world in a human body and lived among us, and put his words into the minds of the Bible writers so that the God- breathed message was recorded accurately in the pages of the Bible. Some Bible authors clearly did feel that the words they were speaking were directly God-given: at the giving of the Ten Commandants at Mount Sinai we are told 'God spoke all these words (Exodus 20:1). When God called Ezekiel to be a prophet, then commanded him, listen carefully and take the heart all the words I speak to you. Go now to your countrymen and speak to them, say to them. "This is what the Sovereign Lord Says" (See Ezekiel 2:1 -3:11). The last book in the Bible is specifically called a God-given 'revelation'.

Each of the letters that claims that the messages are the very words of Jesus (Revelation Chapter 2). It is not surprising, that we have such rich variety in the Bible. All the writers were different. They were individuals to their own right. They were speaking or writing for different audiences. Every Church is made with different personalities and different gifts. But the gift of Holy Spirit takes and binds us together in one fellowship and uses us all to achieve His purpose. Jesus for gave our sins (which only God can do) (Matthew 9:5; Luke 5:20-21. He claimed the ability to be present everywhere (Matthew 18:20:28-20). He said he was the source of all truth and life (John 14:6). At the very beginning of the Bible's account of mankind's creations, 'So God created man in his own image, (Genesis 1:27) Here is the key factor which makes people entirely different from animals. So everyone is marked by God's image. **This is why murder is an outrageous offence.** Jesus compared himself to a good shepherd who is willing to put his personal safety at risk when his sheep are attacked. For the love of Jesus is worth more than silver & gold.

Following Christ means going where He leads, without question.

It means following Him all the way through thick and thin. It is life of faith and trust.

I wondered here and there and at last I was successful in tracing them out in a hilly area where she was running a school with her daughter. I handed over that letter to his wife which mentioned:

When she read it, she melted down, and felt love and affection of her husband. And she invited him respectfully.

Extreme step of divorce is no remedy, but miserably and ill- Effects in the society, that our loving children will be "homeless and handicap". Marriage is mature in the responsibilities, and always need for responsible decisions. So he said to them, “Whoever divorces his wife and marries another woman he commits adultery against her. “And if a woman divorces her husband and marries another she also commits adultery.” (Exodus 20:14).

In the book of ‘Roman’ (7:1-3) St. Paul wrote that “Do you not know, brother- for I am speaking to men who know the law – that the law has authority over a man only as long as he lives? For example, by law a married woman is bound to her husband as long as he is alive, but if her husband dies, she is released from the ‘law of marriage’. Luke 2:8-11

PRISON FOR PEACE

The story of prisoner, one afternoon, while he watching a cinema about a train robbery, he was inspired to go back to his life of crime. He masterminded six train robberies... stopping the trains, holding up the passengers, and running off with their money. This man served 33 years in prison before he was released. He was 59 years old when he came out of jail. His hair had turned gray, and most of his friends died. When he was in the jail, he received a message of Christ that he died on the cross for his sins. May be this message can **change few lives** of the prisoners who have committed crimes, turned to God to find forgiveness and new life. Life changing encounter with the power of Jesus; **Dead people coming to life with Christ.**

The Gospel according to Matthew tells the good news that Jesus is the promised Saviour, the one through whom God fulfilled the promises he made to this people in the Old Testament. This good news is not only for the Jewish people, among whom Jesus was born and lived, but for the whole world. Matthew is arranged. And it begins with the birth of Jesus, describes his baptism and temptation, and then takes up his ministry of preaching, teaching, and healing in Galilee. After the Gospel records Jesus journey from Galilee to Jerusalem and the events of Jesus last week, culminating in his crucifixion and resurrection.

The Bible is the story of God's love. "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).



The Story of God's Love

Luke 15: 11-32 Then Jesus said,

“There was a man who had two sons. The younger of them said to his father,

‘Father, give me the share of the property that will belong to me.

‘So he divided his property between them.

A certain father had two sons. The older son was a hard-working, faithful young man who labored in the father's fields without grumbling or complaining. The younger son was different, however. He loved to play, and as he grew older he became not only lazy but also bad. He developed bad habits of drinking. He wasted money. He became an embarrassment to his father. One day he was weary of being told to work all the time, so he demanded of his father the inheritance that was due him. (Sometimes Jewish sons would get their inheritance before the father died.) The father gave him the money he had coming and the son left for the big city, not to wisely invest the money there but to squander the money in evil ways. He spent it on drinking and gambling and women. Within a short time he was without money-and of course without friends, for those he thought were his friends were only interested in getting his money.

A drought struck the land during this time, and there was little food and few jobs. The young son began to starve. His fine clothes became dirty, torn rags. Finally, he received a job feeding - pigs for a farmer. He was so hungry that he wanted to eat the food that he fed to the pigs. The hunger pangs in his stomach grew worse. He felt miserable. The young man came to his senses when he realized that even the servants at his father's farm were better off than he was. But he also realized that he had sinned against his father.

The Bible says, "When he came to his senses he said, 'How many of my father's hired men have food to spare, and here I am starving to death! I will set out and go back to my father and to him: Father I have sinned against heaven and against you I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired men.' So he got up and went to his father" ,(Luke 15:17-20). Can you imagine how he must have felt as he set out on his trip back home? Certainly he must have felt ashamed for what he had done, for all the hurt and pain he had caused his parents certainly he must have been afraid. What sort of reception would he get? Would the gate be locked? Would the servants even let him in? Would his father speak to him or punish him? Would his father even let him come back home after the embarrassment that he had caused him? As he neared his house he saw a figure standing by the gate, and he noticed that the gate was not closed but open. As he drew closer he noticed that it was his father, looking down the road in his direction.

His father saw him and started to run toward him, Jesus said,

"But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him" (Luke 15:20).

The son began to talk. "Father, Father, I have sinned against God and against you so badly that I am not worthy to be treated as your son anymore. Would you please hire me back as a servant"

But in his excitement it seemed that the father hardly heard the son at all. 'Servants' he shouted. "Servants, come here quickly, and bring the finest robe we have and put it on this boy. Bring sandals. And bring the family ring for his finger. Get food ready for a great feast-the greatest feast we have ever had. Look at what has happened. My boy, my precious-son-he was dead; now he is alive. He' as come back to me! He is here! **Let us rejoice and celebrate!**' So the wayward son was not punished, not reprimanded, not dosed out. The gate was open, not shut. The father was overjoyed, not angry. The son was treated as a son, not as a servant, not even as a criminal.

The Meaning of This story. This story is a dramatic of the parable of the lost son told by Jesus and found in Luke 15:11-32. Jesus often causing parables. What did he mean by this story? Jesus was illustrating the truth that there are only kind of religion in the world today. One kind of religion says that we must earn our way back to God. God is an angry God, and we must appease that anger with sacrifices and rituals. We certain that God will accept us because we never know fully what we can do please him. This is not the religion of the Bible. The other kind of religion, Jesus shows us that like the father in the story, is eager to have us come back.

We do not to earn our way back! God himself welcomes us back. And just as the father put a robe on his son, put sandals on his feet, and put a ring on his finger, so the heavenly Father will make us presentable to himself. This is the most beautiful truth in the Whole world! We cannot make ourselves acceptable to God by anything we do. No rituals of worship, no sacrifices, no amount of good works can ever bring us to the point where we can return to God and say to him that he must let us back into his presence. But if we come_humbly, sorry for what we have done, if we come as the son returned to his father, then Jesus says that God will have the same attitude toward us that the father had toward the son. We will be welcomed back! And God himself will wash away all our sins. He will cleanse us from everything we have done wrong. It will be as if our sins never existed! Psalm 103 : 9 - 13 .

God Wants us to Come Back The whole message of the Bible is that God so loves us that he wants us to come back to him. Just as the father stood longing, waiting for his son to return, so God longs for us to return to him. But how can God forgive our sins? Does he just ignore them? That is not fair, is it? No, God does not ignore our sins. Our sins are punished. But God loves us so much that he allowed his Son Jesus Christ to be punished for those sins. Remember the Bible passage at the beginning of this story? "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, Gave for what? He gave Jesus to bear the punishment for sin that we should bear. So when we return to him and-confess our sins, he can forgive us because he tells us that all the sin we have committed has been paid for by the death of Christ on-the cross. The book of proverbs is a collection of moral and religious teachings in the form of saying and proverbs, much of it has to do with practical everyday concerns.

It begins with the reminder that “To have knowledge, you must first have reverence for the LORD,” and then goes on to deal with matters not only of religious morality, but also of common sense and good manners. It’s many short sayings reveal the insights of ancient Israelite teachers about family relations. Some deal with the matters of concern in social relationships, others with the need for self-control. Much is said about such qualities as humanity, patience, respect to all. The book of ‘PROVERBS’ – A most down-to-earth book: “If you call out for insight and cry about for understanding, and if you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure, then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God” (Prov. 2:3-5).

Dearest, in the Bible, the book of proverbs, its education prepares us for the street and the market place, (Prov. 1:20-21). The book offers the warm advice we get by growing up in a good family: practical guidance for successfully making our way in the world. It covers small questions as well as large talking to much. The first nine chapters, which explain the purpose of proverbs of proverb’s wisdom, are spoken from father to son. Many times the fatherly voice says, “My son”. Some of the advice seems particularly well suited to young people: warning against joining gangs, for instance, or urgent cautions against sex outside marriage. But the central message of proverbs applies to anyone, old or young: “Get wisdom at all costs.” It is a plea to strain our mind and our ears searching for the voice way to live.

Those who learn the practical and godly wisdom of proverbs not only sleep better, they succeed and become able to help their family and friends. Fools and scoffers, though they appear successful, will eventually pay the cost of their life style. Much of proverb’s practical advice and teaches depends on a healthy respect for God (1:7) affecting every aspect of life. Proverbs frankly concedes that the wise-path will not be chosen by many: it is easier to live carelessly and godlessly. But those who choose to live by proverbs will get success and safety, and more: they will get to know God himself. “Then you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God” (Proverbs 2:5).

The book of proverbs is the skill of living in God’s way, ‘the fear of the Lord...’ fear does not mean terror or dread in this, but rather it means respect. If we respect God, then we shall respect his wishes, and live in ways which please him. The wise person avoids adulterous relationship (chapter 5,6,7) and remains faithful to his wife. These proverbs which are said to come from ‘King Solomon’. Some of the most common topics are wisdom, folly, attitudes to wealth, the tongue, discipline, sexuality, family life, honesty and pride. King wrote, “A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.” Proverbs 15:1. “Today, commit your works into the Lord, and your thoughts shall be established” Proverbs 16:3.” Pleasant words are as a honey comb sweet to the soul, and health to the bones. (Proverbs 16:24).
