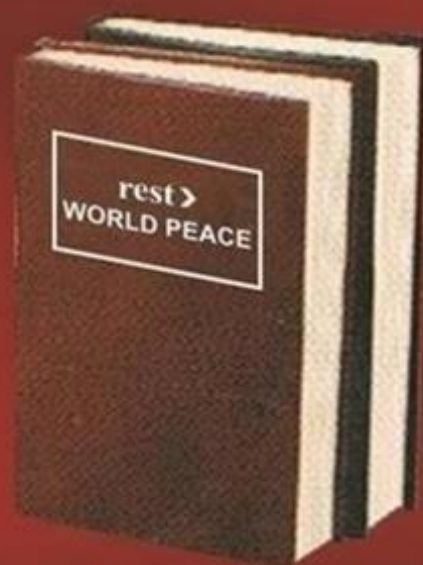

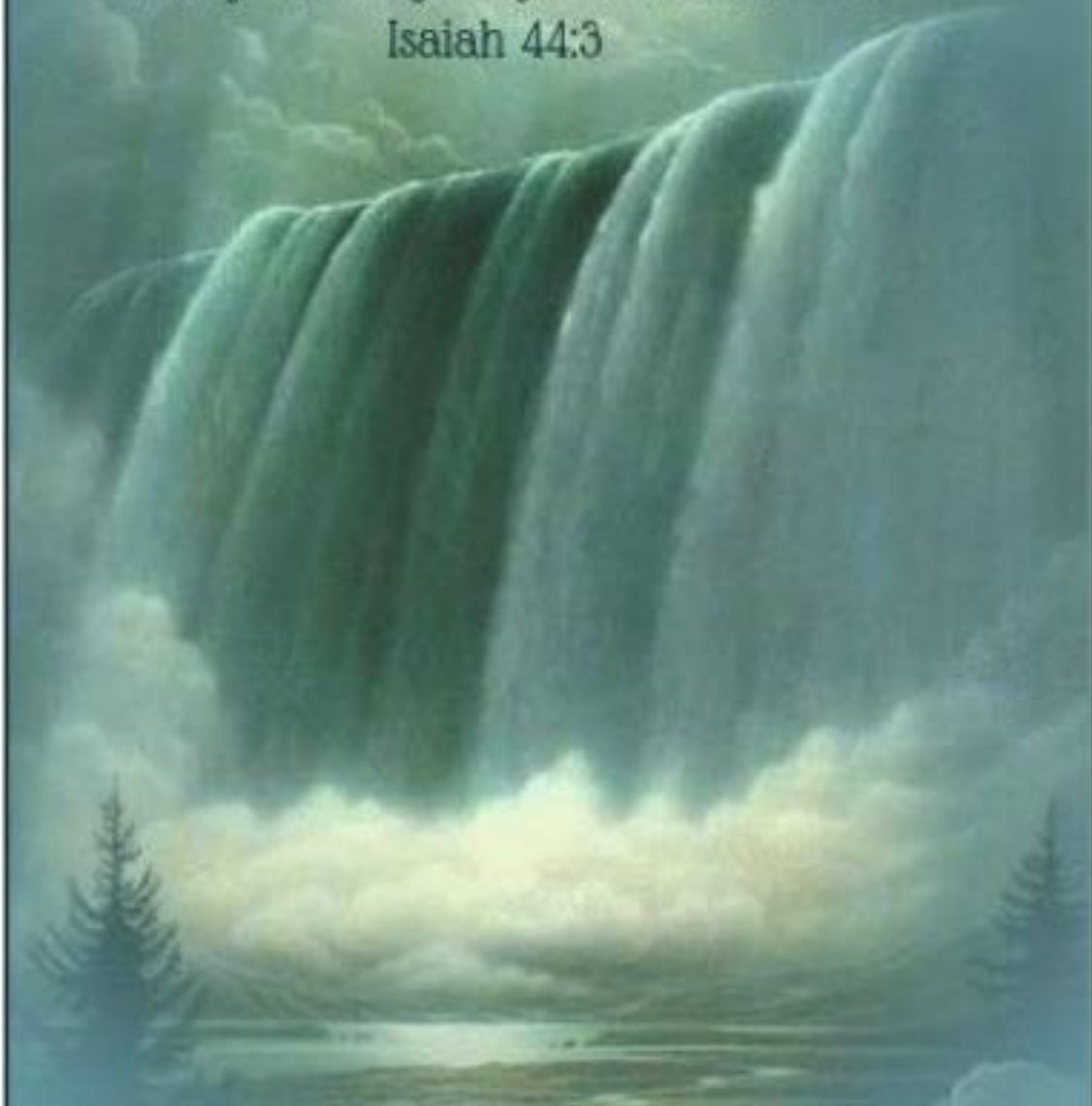

Sir, I am Jai Pal Behl, son of Late Shri Bharat Lal Behl, who was a Great Freedom Fighter.

He launched a Magazine 'Sarfaroosh'(1966). I still remember his last words,

"After my pen stops bring your pen in action, so that my spirit remains alive through your pen. Do everything in such a way that every work is entirely dependent on you. Pray for all. Through prayer, people, things, problems and circumstances can be transformed. Prayer is the channel 'God' uses to send His Message to hearts and minds, and inspire dreams".

My humble contribution to help to spread the 'Word of God' the message of peace at world – level, God speaks us our surrounding, circumstances and through history. His faithfulness continues through all generations. Not only is He the creator and Ruler of the universe, but He also the Savior of the world.

Sir, I live in Chandigarh, the city of peace. In the year 1983, because of serious throat problem, I was going to be admitted into Christian Medical Hospital, Ludhiana (Punjab). On entering the hospital, I saw a Bill Board which said, "come to me, I will give you rest. Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" - Jesus Christ.

In the old testament the book of (Proverbs 25:21 we are told to feed our enemies when he is hungry. But instruction to love our enemies came from Jesus in his Sermon on the Mount, which is beginning of peace. **Sermon on the Mount**: upholding the law with the highest sense of respect. Matthew 5:17- "Do not think that I came to destroy the law of the prophets, I did not come to destroy, but to fulfill." In the New Testament - The book Luke Chapter 6 we have a summary of his teaching : "Love your Enemies. Do good to those who curse you, bless those who abuse you. If anyone strikes on the cheek, offer the other, and love your neighbor as yourself." A Story of Redemption. (A fall of man – Genesis Chapter 3).

God chose Jacob to extent His blessings to all. So the – whole world to join the “Chosen People”

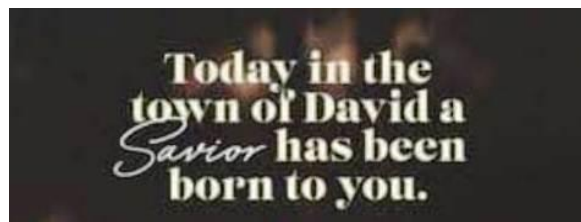
THE STORY OF JOSEPH (GENESIS 37) Jacob had twelve sons. One of them Joseph was hated by his brothers and sold as a slave. Far from home, in a very strange land, he was sold to work in the house of high governmental official. Joseph's story is an example of how God works for good **even in adverse circumstances (Romans 8:28)**. God had worked in such a strange and beautiful way to make Joseph second in command of all Egypt. During the hundreds of years that the children of Israel lived in Egypt they grew into a very strong nation. After Joseph's death, the king of Egypt oppressed the people of Israel and made them slaves.

THE BIRTH OF MOSES (EXODUS 1:8-2:25) as the people grew in number, the kings of Egypt began to oppress them and make them slaves. God heard their cries and decided to deliver them, through a man by the name Moses. When 'Moses' was an old man, eighty years old God called him into service. While Israel was in the wilderness, on the way God gave Ten Commandments which were to govern their life. God said, “You shall not make any graven image (EXODUS 20:1-4), **or** any likeness of anything that is in heaven, on the earth, or in the water. You shall not bow down to them or serve them.” Moses also commanded to them 'the Lord your God will rise up for your Prophet like me from among you own people; **you must listen to everything he tells you"**. Acts 3:22.

GOD ALSO RISES UP SAMUEL TO BE HIS PROPHET FOR ISRAEL. (1 Samuel 1:9-28 and 2:18-26). David was Israel's greatest king. (1SAMUEL16). God send the Prophet Samuel to young shepherd, named David. From this man's descendants. God has brought to Israel 'Messiah' the Savior Jesus, as he promised.

Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you: he is the Messiah. The Lord. Luke 2:11

More than two thousand years ago a girl (Mary) lived in a city called Nazareth. She was a virgin. There was an arrangement that she should marry a man called Joseph, a carpenter in Nazareth. Something very unusual happened to this girl. **An angel appeared to her one day** and told her that she was going to have a baby. This would be a very special baby because he would become the Savior of the world. Mary was excited and thrilled that the baby she was going to have was to be the Son of God, the Savior of the world! However, she was also worried. "How can I have a baby she asked, when I am still a virgin?" Don't worry" said the angel, "God will work a miracle for you." This answer helped Mary to understand the plan of God. (Luke 1:5-55). **The angel also told... His name should be called "Jesus"**, which means a person who will save his people from their sin. (Isaiah.7-14).

On the same night that Jesus was born, there were shepherds out in the fields around Bethlehem. It was late at night, and was very dark. Suddenly, there was a very bright light. The shepherds were afraid. An angel stood in front of them from heaven. The shepherd had never seen an angel before this time. The angel said, "Don't be afraid! I bring you some very good news!" The Shepherd listened very closely as the angel continued, "This night the Savior, God's Son, was born, right here in Bethlehem." This news shocked those shepherds. God's Son was born! They knew the promise God had given by sending His Son into the world. The angel said to them, "if you will go to Bethlehem, you will find this Baby wrapped up in a cloth and lying in a manger." And then suddenly many angels appeared on the hills. The angels begin to praise God saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven and peace on earth to all who are pleasing Him." (LUKE 2:1-18).

The shepherd went to Bethlehem and saw the baby Jesus. They praised and thanked God for sending His Son. After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, see, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem and asked, "Where is the one who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him." When King Herod heard this he was disturbed, and all Jerusalem with him... and the star they had seen in the East went ahead of them until it stopped over the place where the Child was. When they saw the star, they were overjoyed. Some people want to know to why Jesus is called the son of God, as God is not a human being who may have a son. However, the things, which we have read, we see that Jesus is son of God because **he was born through the power of God. (Luke 1:34).**

Sir, each year when I read the Christmas story. I am impressed with the role that the angels play in it. As per history: when Jesus was thirty years old, He was given the power of God to do the work which He had been sent to do. Sermon on the Mount: Remains important for us today, which concerns the character, duties, privileges, and destiny of the citizens of the kingdom of heaven (chapters Matthew 5-7). "if anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me." (Matthew 16:24-26). Jesus was given authority over all the works of Satan: Sin, disease, demons, and even death. John 11:17-44; Mark Chapter 2. '**Nicodemus**', a member of the Jewish ruling council. He came to Jesus at night and said: "Rabbi, we know you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the miraculous signs you are doing. (John 3: 1-21).

A Reason for secrecy, this meeting took place at night, in secret. Nicodemus was a ruling member to the Pharisees, a group that violently opposed Jesus. He likely risked danger by meeting with Jesus. One more references to Nicodemus indicate that Jesus must have had a strong effect on him. He stood up for Jesus at the Jewish ruling council (7:50) and helped prepare Jesus body for burial (19:39). Life everlasting with God, which begins at conversion – Born again, through rebirth (John 3:1-21). **The story of Lazarus.** The story of Lazarus, Mary, and Martha is a Bible story about the miraculous resurrection of Lazarus from the dead by Jesus. The story is told in the Gospel of John (Chapter 11-12). Lazarus is brought to life (John 38-44).

History records they were severely beaten with many stripes and
were cast into prison and their feet put in stock we read in Book Acts.

The apostles Peter and John, were arrested for preaching through the resurrection of the dead. We read in Acts 4:1-2. The real power at work in the Book ACTS. **“Saul” was till threats against the Lord’s disciples.** He believed that salvation could be obtained by obedience to all the laws of ‘Moses’ that God had given to His people... but a view religious movement was a group of people who claimed to be followers of ‘Jesus’, a man who had been crucified, but they now believed had ‘risen’ from the dead, ascended to heaven, and would return in power and great glory. He felt on the ground and heard a voice, “Saul, why do you persecute me?” verse 5 Chapter 9 “who are you, Lord?” Saul asked, “I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting...” He never saw Jesus before His death and resurrection. When Jesus appeared on the road to Damascus, he was getting a persecutor and a violent man; God turned many a ‘Saul’ into a ‘Paul’ Jesus himself call Paul “... a chosen vessel of mine”. God said to Ananias, “Go” ! This man is chosen instrument to proclaim my name Pl. see (Book Acts 9:1-9; 22:6-16; 26:12-23).

Acts Chapter 22- Paul’s Jerusalem Sermon: He begins his message to the mob. 1 to 3 verses “Brethren and fathers, hear my defense before you now.” He tells of his Jewish upbringing and background. “I am indeed a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, taught according to the strictness of our father’s law, and was zealous toward God as you all are today.” In the verse 4-5 he tells how he persecuted Christians. “I presented this way to the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women, as also the high priest hears me witness, and all the council of the elders, from whom I also received letters, and went to Damascus to bring in chains even those who were there to Jerusalem to be punished.” In the verse 6 to 16 he describes his supernatural experience on the way to Damascus...”

Jesus Christ show his long - suffering (Patience) with other people, by showing Paul as an example of a murder of Christians, now chosen by Jesus, to carry the Gospel of salvation in many parts of the world. The Book 'Acts' and the letters from 'Roman to Revelation' discuss the deep significance of the resurrected Christ presented in (symbolic language) that would have been understood by all believers of that day. The Book of Revelation tells: “your concern should not be when the world will end, instead, your main focus should be to seek God to be spiritually prepared for the times that are coming, and also encourage us to live pure and holy lives (2 Peter 3:15- 18). The Gospel is the only message in the world that can powerfully bring a person not just to conversion, but to everlasting safety and joy in the presence of a holy and glorious God.

God is love, actively demonstrated his love through Jesus Christ, through him, offered salvation to all mankind. The book of Isaiah is named a great prophet. A notable theme of his chapters is that God is the Lord of history, and his plan for his people, including their mission to all nations, who will be blessed through Israel. Bible tells that King David was one who took on himself the sufferings of his people. He even wept for the suffering of his enemies (Psalm 16:9) David was a generous man. When his enemies fell he mourned for them. When God rejected Saul from the kingship of Israel, David was revealed to Prophet Samuel, who anointed him, (1 Samuel 16:1-13). He stood out as bright and shining lights for the God; man of action, tender lover, justice, loyal friend, and all that men find the will of God, who made and shaped him for his destiny. David becomes king over Israel and only to serve the God. David was thirty years old when he became king, and reigned for forty years. The Lord’s promise to King David that Israel would never lack the leadership they needed. God’s promise to David: II Samuel 7:8-29 said to Prophet Nathan, “Now then, tells my servant David, ‘this is what the Lord Almighty says: I took you from the pasture and from following the flock to ruler over my people. “I have been with you wherever you have gone, and I have cut off all your enemies from before you. For the sake your word and according to your will, you have done this great thing and made it known to your servant. How great are you. There is no-one like you and there is no God but you. And who is like your people Israel – the one nation on earth that God went out to redeem as a people for himself, and to make a name for himself and to perform great wonders by driving out nations and their gods from before your people, whom you redeemed from Egypt? THANK GOD FOR JESUS

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God's greatest revelation of himself to us is in the life and ministry and teaching of Jesus Christ. He comes directly to us through the Holy Spirit. Down through the ages he has met with men and women personally: with Moses at the burning bush, or with others in different ways. He has revealed himself and his truth to us in the Bible. For example, the four gospels give us accounts of Jesus being crucified. In Romans, we find a closely argued explanation of what the cross really means, and of how an event on a Friday can transform our relationship with the living God. In His wisdom and love God has chosen to give us the rich and complex collection of history and theology, of poetry and prophecy, of stories of Jesus and personal letters, as a message from him to all who read or hear it.

As St. Paul put it when he was writing all scripture in God-breathed or inspired by God in a Unique way (2 Timothy 3:16). His statement that all the Old Testament, scriptures were God-breathed, he taught that they were in fact 'the very words of God' (Romans 3:2). In the way the believers of the early were able to say that the words of one of the Psalms were actually God speaking by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of King David (Act 4:25). Besides teaching that Old Testament Scriptures were inspired by God, Jesus claimed God's authority for his own words (John 14:24). Throughout the New Testament the apostles were aware that the message they proclaimed and the teaching they gave was not theirs but God's.

They could not be silent, because they had to 'Obey God' (Acts 5:29). St. Paul received his message not from any man, but by revelation from Jesus Christ. (Acts Chapter 9) The book of Revelation is also called God given (Revelation 1:1). We find it hard to understand how the infinite God came to this world in a human body and lived among us, and put his words into the minds of the Bible writers so that the God-breathed message was recorded accurately in the pages of the Bible. Some Bible authors clearly did feel that the words they were speaking were directly God-given: at the giving of the Ten Commandments at Mount Sinai we are told 'God spoke all these words (Exodus 20:1). When God called Ezekiel to be a prophet, then commanded him, listen carefully and take the heart all the words I speak to you. Go now to your countrymen and speak to them, say to them. "This is what the Sovereign Lord Says" (See Ezekiel 2:1 -3:11). The last book in the Bible is specifically called a God-given 'revelation'.

Each of the letters that claims that the messages are the very words of Jesus (Revelation Chapter 2) St. John, tells us that there would simply not be enough room for all the books of anyone were to try to record all the deeds of Jesus (John 21:25). Dear, it is not surprising, that we have such rich variety in the Bible. All the writers were different. They were individuals to their own right. They were speaking or writing for different audiences. Every Church is made with different personalities and different gifts. But the gift of Holy Spirit takes and binds us together in one fellowship and uses us all to achieve His purpose. Jesus forgave our sins (which only God can do) (Matthew 9:5; Luke 5:20-21). He claimed the ability to be present everywhere (Matthew 18:20:28"20).

Jesus said he was the source of all truth and life (John 14:6). At the very beginning of the Bible's account of mankind's creation, 'So God created man in his own image, (Genesis 1:27) Here is the key factor which makes people entirely different from animals. So everyone is marked by God's image. This is why murder is an outrageous offence. Jesus compared himself to a good shepherd who is willing to put his personal safety at risk when his sheep are attacked. Following Christ means going where He leads, without question. It means following Him all the way through thick and thin. It is life of faith and trust.

The Bible is an amazing book. With God's full authority, it sets out his design for the world. The unity of the prove that the Bible is the word of God, by about forty different men, different languages, and many different countries. And a book of such unity, written over a period of many centuries, was composed by man. Surely it is more reasonable to believe that the Bible is inspired by God. **Jesus Christ Himself is the central person in this unified plan of salvation**, from Genesis to Revelation (66 books) the scheme of redemption progresses from "Someone is coming" to "Someone has come" to "Someone will come again". (2 Timothy 3:16). Bible prophecy and its fulfillment are convincing evidence that the Bible is God's Word. The word prophecy is frequently used in the Bible to mean, "To speak for or on behalf of God." However, the word prophecy is also used to mean, "To predict future events under the influence of divine guidance." Prophecy is not a lucky guess. No one but God Himself could know the future. If, therefore the prophecies have been literally fulfilled, only God could have inspired them. They were frank in their witness. They did not claim authorship of their teachings. **It is a historical religion. It is not man's imagination** or a collection of myths, legends and human traditions.

In the Old Testament, we are first introduced to God. It tells of His power in creation and it is filled with prophecies that (speak of Christ, his Work, and how he suffered for sins that he might bring us to God. 1 Peter 3:18). The call of Jesus Christ is Universal, and prophecies of his ruler ship: A great prophet Isaiah, speaking of the future reign of Jesus Christ, describes what kind of ruler He will be ..." (Isaiah 9: 6, 7). There will be no end to peace under Jesus Christ's reign. The Prince of peace will bring calm and goodwill to a world: Under Jesus Christ's righteous ruler ship, mankind will at last learn God's ways and experience this wonderful peace. Educational institutions will teach people how to live. "They shall not hurt nor destroy in my entire holy mountain, for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters covers the sea". **God's Plan for the entire world** – spiritual 'rest' of the kingdom of God, and looking forward to promised 'Future Rest'. The rest reminds us of the creation and of our creator. The wonderful news of the coming to kingdom of God is the heart and core of Jesus Christ message for humanity. He will be the Rule in the kingdom of God. "Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying: 'The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He will reign forever and ever!'" (Revelation 11:15). Matthew 6:33 Jesus tells the crowds continually "seek first kingdom and God's righteousness and all these things will be added to you." When Jesus left the disciples to heaven he gave them his promise. I will come again in your heart 'Forever'. We do not pray for the Physical return of Christ, but that His kingdom come today in our hearts and in our lives. Jesus says: my kingdom of is not something, for it already exists.

On the cross and in the resurrection he speaks to his followers as the one who is over all powers of this world: "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me". 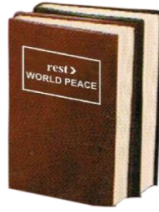

Its many short sayings reveal the insights of ancient Israelite teachers about family relations. Some deal with the matters of concern in social relationships, others with the need for self-control. Much is said about such qualities as humanity, patience, respect for all. The book of ‘PROVERBS’ – A most down-to-earth book: “If you call out for insight and cry about for understanding, and if you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure, then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God” (Prov. 2:3-5).

Dears, in the Bible, the book of proverbs, its education prepares us for the street and the market place, (Prov. 1:20-21). The book offers the warm advice we get by growing up in a good family: practical guidance for successfully making our way in the world. It covers small questions as well as large talking to much. The first nine chapters, which explain the purpose of proverbs of proverb’s wisdom, are spoken from father to son. **Many times the fatherly voice says, “My son”.** Some of the advice seems particularly well suited to young people: warning against joining gangs, for instance, or urgent cautions against sex outside marriage. But the central message of proverbs applies to anyone, old or young: “Get wisdom at all costs.” It is a plea to strain our mind and our ears searching for the voice way to live.

Those who learn the practical and godly wisdom of proverbs not only sleep better, they succeed and become able to help their family and friends. Fools and scoffers, though they appear successful, will eventually pay the cost of their life style. Much of proverb’s practical advice and teaches depends on a healthy respect for God (1:7) affecting every aspect of life. Proverbs frankly concedes that the wise-path will not be chosen by many: it is easier to live carelessly and godlessly. But those who choose to live by proverbs will get success and safety, and more: they will get to know God himself. “Then you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God” (Proverbs 2:5).

The book of proverbs is the skill of living in God’s way, ‘the fear of the Lord...’ fear does not mean terror or dread in this, but rather it means respect. If we respect God, then we shall respect his wishes, and live in ways which please him. The wise person avoids adulterous relationship (chapter 5,6,7) and remains faithful to his wife. 2 CORINTHIANS 5:20

This person might negotiate agreements, meet with foreign leaders, even play the part of peace maker, when trouble arises.

But, dears, when we read the apostle Paul’s words in (2 Corinthians 5:20) that as ‘believers’ we are to be Christ’s ambassadors, reject false teachings, and strive to understand, and higher calling of ‘believer’ ministry. This higher calling is what Paul is emphasizing in Chapter 5 of the letter, where he notes that God is the ultimate judge of all creation. We out of love, reverence, and fear of the Lord, ought to not only live in a way that reflects our faith but convince other people to do the same.

Dears, indeed, he wrote, we are to no longer live for ourselves but to Christ. “him who died for them and was raised again” (V5). We are a “new creation” (V. 17), reborn and reconciled to God. That reconciliation is the ultimate goal! St. Paul indicates – for, once separated from God by sin, in Christ we are now rejoined with our Heavenly Father. It is an opportunity open to everyone who repents and believes in Jesus, and it is up to all of us to do part to spread that message so that all people can be reconciled too. Given all this, ‘Paul’ then writes “we are therefore Christ’s ambassadors, to God” (2 Corinthians 5:20)

He meant that all ‘believers’ should see themselves as representatives of God. And were to behave accordingly. They had an important job to do: And delivers His message so others could know Him, too. **Likewise, an ambassador of Christ** helps arrange matters on behalf of the Lord. He or she is tasked with helping arrange might be constructed to who is responsible for feeding the hungry or teaching the people. 

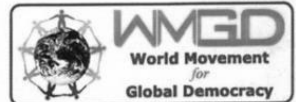


